News from South America


Dear Mary Jo,

ISSSEEM Conference





Dr. Ellen Kaye Gehrke and Dr. Mary Jo Bulbrook presented at the ISSSEEM Annual Conference June 29, 2009 in Boulder, CO: Horse Sense and The Human Heart Recognizing the Heart-to-Heart Bonding Between Humans and Horses Via the Measure of Heart Rate Variability Synchronicity.

This was the first time that ISSSEEM had a live presentation with animals – namely horses at the conference for participants to experience a live demonstration of the topic









of heart to heart bonding between humans and horses. An enthusiastic audience gathered first inside to hear about Dr. Gehrke's research and then went outside the conference site to a outdoor entrance where two horses were brought for the workshop participants to experience first hand communicating with horses — both giving and receiving messages through an established heart connection.

Dr. Gehrke's research findings indicate: "Humans can, in real time, adjust their emotional state in the presence of horses and experience the positive feelings that come from connection and relationship with another being who is 100% present." stated Dr Gehrke at the conference. The research had five phases:

Phase 1: By measuring HRV can we determine that an energetic relationship exists between horses and humans when interacting in a guided series of activities?

Phase 2: What is the average HRV of various horses during a 24-hour reading?

Purpose: to gain baseline HRV's on horses to determine similarities and differences between horses and humans.

Phase 3: Is there a bio-emotional relationship between pairs of horses and in herd dynamics?

Purpose: We wanted to look at the sentient nature of horses to determine their emotional responses to other relationships with members of their herd.

Phase 4/5: Exploration of the energetic relationship between horses and humans 1:1 ECG monitoring

Purpose: We wanted to know if horses responded in similar emotional ways to humans they know and humans they do not know.

The workshop group then went outside where two horses were present for the workshop participants to experience first hand – presence, awareness, open hearts, saying hello, being presence, communicating with touch and debriefing the experiences. Magic occurred as hearts opened and connected. This was an "in the moment" experience where hearts attuned to become one in spirit. Two techniques titled: Grounding and Heart Attunement from Dr. Bulbrook's Transform Your Life through Energy Medicine Program serving as the foundation for Energy Medicine Animal Program were shared and practiced. From this base participants were able to communicate and connect with the horse at deep levels.

We tried getting someone to facilitate reading with the group every afternoon but unfortunately it did not work out. We gave the matter no further thought. At the party we did however ask if anyone wanted to read

for the prize. Much to my surprise 6 little ones, 8–10 year olds came forward. All read well! We had to improvise on the spot and we awarded them each with a R20 prize. The teacher thanked us for motivating reading and was very excited by the buzz the prizes created under the rest of the kids.

Money matters

Thank you for all your money gifts. We raised a whopping R4000 (\$400 US)! There is enough left over for electricity and foodcontributions in January, February and March 2010

Christmas Party

Once again Tracey and friends sponsored the 140 hotdogs, sausages, juice as well as the Lucky Dip toy & sweet parcels. We bought some extra hotdogs and juice as we anticipated some "extra visitors" It is very difficult to turn a hungry child away just because they are not part of Sizanani. We were astounded that even after two hotdogs each, most kids came back for a third and if there was a 4th going would have eaten that too.

We bought large brown paper packets and into these went:

- Lucky dip sweet & toy parcels
- pen & pencilstoothpaste and
- extra sweets & chips
- toothpaste and toothbrush
- generous amounts of Wedgewood nougat
- soapcrackers
- exercise books
- crayons and colouring books

As a special treat each kid got a 20ml syringe (thanks Erica!) filled with condensed milk

with a marshmallow stuck on the nozzle – these were great fun! We got enough toys donated that we could pack age appropriate toy packets for each kid. There were also enough extras for the "uninvited" visitors.

The 6 Goggos who run the scheme received large boxes of biscuits and hand cream. Approximately 8 black bags of clothing were also left for the Goggos to distribute amongst the kids

Thanks to Clare, Kath, Michael, Peter, Nomusa, Jacqui and Florence for your help on the day. Also a special thanks to Florence without whom nothing could happen. She is the one who collects all the drop-offs and sorts and stashes. She truly is my right hand, my left hand and most often both legs as well!

We left behind full tummies, raspberry stained red mouths and sticky (condensed milk) hands and faces. One can hope that for those few hours the deep sadness that characterize so many of their expressions were alleviated and that things were just "good".

Finally, I leave you with the haunting words of our young MC, Nhlanhla (15 yrs) who wrote a poem especially for the occasion

A Spiritual Traveler AUSTRALIA CANADA SOUTH AFRICA



In his bestselling novel, The Celestine Prophecy, James Redfield describes his journey of spiritual awakening during a transitional period of his life. In the story he faces many adventures and unexpected challenges as he seeks to understand nine spiritual insights on an ancient manuscript found in the jungles of Peru.

Like Redfield, my life has taken a path of spiritual unfolding following new adventures that I could not have imagined. Some of the most transformative moments have occurred during the international spiritual tours with Energy Medicine Partnerships (EMP), Inc. Since 2007 I've travelled to New Zealand, Peru, South Africa, Canada, and most recently Australia. Each trip afforded a deeply personal experience of self-discovery, renewal and being. There were invaluable insights revealed

and opportunities to give, feel, receive and share the wonders of the land, and the wisdom of ancient traditions. Special connectedness and



synchronicities emerged as I shared my journey with others on similar healing paths.

In Australia, the theme was the Shared Journey as the U.S. and Australian Energy Medicine community gathered Port Macquarie, NSW. We journeyed to Alice Springs and Uluru. As I walked the land around Uluru (Ayers Rock - the central root and heartbeat of aborigine culture}, I was reminded to be grounded in my energies and be aware of my surroundings. The Aborigines believe in the Oneness of everything and that the plants, animals and all of nature are an extended family in the great

cycle of life and death. Aborigine elder Bob Randall calls this Kanyini; the principle of connectedness through caring and responsibility for one another. "It is not about me-ness but instead our-ness" he said. The land and all of nature will give us information to guide our life.

In New Zealand I attended the Maori Mystery School taught by Dr. Rose Pere, Maori Tohuna,



nestled deep in the North Island's Urewara forest. I went to New Zealand to heal a wounded heart and give myself permission to be my true to self and to radiate my essence. The teachings and incredible natural beauty of New Zealand awakened me to my authentic and loving self. The energy of New Zealand is Aroha unconditional love derived from the presence and breath of the Godhead. The Maori believe that we are all a unique, divine creation. As Rose said "You are absolutely unique - there is no one like you on this planet or in the universe – love yourself to the nth degree – be true to yourself – you are a miracle in expression".

The trip to Peru was very special because it satisfied a longing to reconnect in a more profound and transcendent way with the land where I spent my childhood. Feeling the energy of Machu Pichu, the Sacred Valley and sites empowered me to connect with my inner child and cultivate a childlike attitude of joy and wonder. I could see my life and the world through new eyes. Visiting the sacred sites was a very cleansing experience that washed away my doubts, fears and old patterns. My heart opened at a deep level, releasing the fear of being vulnerable and not being enough. In Peru, the nature spirits brought me back to a place of awareness reconnecting me with Source and the nurturing and healing power of nature. I was reminded to be open – to really feel and be fully alive. I cried a lot.



The Canadian theme was Uniting Healers Worldwide. Healers from around the world gathered with a common intention to heal, love, and laugh, and in

the process a truly magical. It is a phenomena known in China as Qichang or group generated energy field with healing effect. As the groups intention aligns there is a synchronicity and cohesion as the individual hara (intentionality) aligns with the group and we became One. The energy of the collective intention of the group shifts when we become heart-centered and focused and embrace with love the Divine in each other and be One in Spirit.

In South Africa, living at the Escabini Zulu Cultural Village was an adventure of trusting and surrendering to the guidance of Spirit. I felt that Spirit was trying to broaden my view of the world energetically and open me to the greater flow of the Divine within. There was a strong sense of place and history as I stood on hallowed ground embracing a new culture, continent, and worldview at the same time. I learned about balance. gratitude and loyalty to self, and that we are all supported and guided to fulfill all our dreams. We must tap into our spiritual resources to identify what changes and patterns are blocking us from moving forward and to enable us to grow as healers.

I am very grateful to Energy Medicine Partnerships and all of those who shared their lives with me during the tours. It truly is a memorable journey as we are changed by experiences that we will cherish for the rest of our lives.
