Articles of Incorporation Addendum

Akamai University's Purpose - Educational

Not for Profit 501 (c) (3)

Prohibited Activities

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributed to, its members, directors, officers, or other private persons except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of purposes set for in these articles of incorporation.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation, shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on(a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Code or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductable under Section 170 (c)(2) of the Code.

Distribution of Assets

Upon the dissolution of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment or provision for payment of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501 c 3 of the Internal Revenue Code or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Such distribution shall be made in accordance with all applicable provisions of the laws of this state.

Succession

The term of office and vacancies are spelled out in the Articles of Incorporation Bylaws and identify the procedure for succession pertaining to all State requirements and following the purpose and goals of the organization.
