The Archway of Light is a bridge between two worlds, a framework between realities, a way to smoothly communicate with the spiritual realm.

Set the intention to communicate with someone.

Say a prayer, calling on Source to provide a clear pathway of light between worlds.

Create the “Archway of Light” in your mind.

Holding your hands above your head, hands stretching forward to honor and communicate with someone who has made their transition. Call spiritual forces to the “gateway” of interdimensional thought transfer through light vibration.

Invite the spirit of the person who has passed to go through the archway. As the person’s spirit moves through the archway, she /he is able to deliver a message of light between person(s) who participate in this process.

(Someone can serve as a substitute for the person who has passed and share what comes through to them from the person who has passed.)

This process helps dissolve as much grief and sense of loss as the person is able to release at this point in time. It facilitates letting go of struggles within a family or between loved ones that had become crusted or tarnished with “issues”.

Optional Process:

The “Archway of Light” can be done with a person in physical form who desires to release “burdens” attached to someone who has passed. The person desiring to release “stuff” walks through the “Archway of Light” held by the person who has passed and others who are on the other side as well those in physical form who desire to assist in this spiritual ritual of forgiveness and return to Divine light and love.

The “Archway of Light” assists in dissolving grief, eliminating unfinished dynamics that no longer serve the soul — the lessons have been received. It assists both the soul of the person who has passed and those left behind. It can assist others to move easily from one dimension to another and resolve unfinished business with others who have made their transition into the light.
