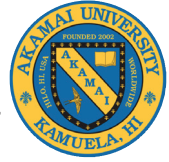




AU is designated an ASIC Premier Accredited University

Our international student body represents more than forty-five nations across five continents. Akamai encourages its students to personalize their studies, address important needs of their home communities, and to address the changing demands of their

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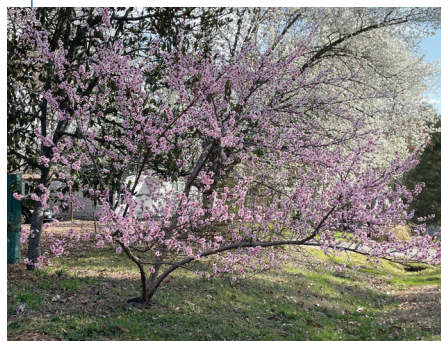
Spring at AU Headquarters

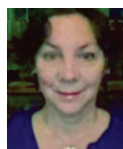

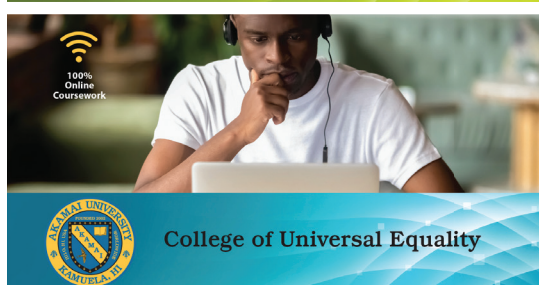
