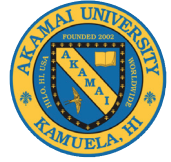


## AU begins a new year; reflects on growth and opportunities

Akamai University and ASIC

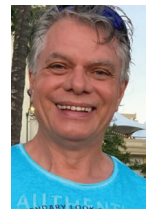
