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Program Designer: Dr. Bulbrook is uniquely qualified to serve in this role due to her lifetime commitment as a dedicated university academic with over 50+ years in Higher Education in multiple countries and on-going clinical practice. She is a master teacher / practitioner / educator with ground theory research methodology – culturally and content specific with a heart2heart, person2person, soul2soul perspective.

Dr. Bulbrook addressed during her extensive career **blending Complementary Alternative Medicine (CAM) and Complementary Integrative Health (CIH)** to diverse worldwide populations and countries in need. Her work is infused with **Virginia Satir's Model of Change. Virginia promoted the energy of achieving Peace Within, Peace Without, and Peace Among** treating all people regardless of their culture, race, gender, religion, economic status, education or political views.

She served in a significant role in the spread of Healing Touch in North America as well as the other countries from the original program designed by Janet Mentgen. She also taught as well as with Dr. John Thie, creator of **Touch For Health** who invited her to take his work worldwide.

Certificate Program in Complementary Integrative Health (CIH) Therapies: Healing through Creative Arts Program.

Part 1 Family Wellness & Support

During this course, the student can experience interventions from a variety of approaches such as: Transform Your Life through Energy Medicine, Healing Touch, Reiki, Therapeutic Touch, Energy Medicine, Touch for Health, Energy Psychology, Bio Energetic Wellness, Yoga, Tai Chi or Qi Gong, Traditional Chinese Medicine, Natural Healing, Sound Healing, Dance, Movement Therapy & Creative Arts.

The certificate includes identifying and documenting the family's health status including body, mind-emotion, and spiritual aspects as well as the client. Through this in-depth analysis, the student explores their own energetic, family, and cultural imprinting that is affecting his / her journey. Once identified the interventions includes learning ways and strategies to break patterns that influence health and well-being following the expert in the change process Virginia Satir who was the key launcher of therapeutic family therapy.

[Ethical dimensions](#) and [Code of Ethics and Standards of Practice Document](#) guide in providing complementary integrative care are studied and practiced.

Part 2 Applying what was learned to the desired population to be addressed / Certificate for Healing through Creative Arts

This usually takes 6 months to a year or year and half depending on the time commitment a student is able to complete and provide the documentation of the journey to qualify for the designated title. It is done virtually individually as well could be studies with peers. Some opportunities may exist for in person experiences with faculty in the future.

The graduate will be awarded a Certificate of completion as well as Board Certified in Complementary Integrative Health (CIH) or Complementary Alternative Medicine as a Family Wellness Supporter, Educator, and / or Researcher if that is the goal.

Part 3 Reflection and Your Story

The student submits their credentials to the Energy Medicine Partnerships Affiliate with Akamai University for awarding the Certificate and appropriate Continuing Education Units. The CAM / CIH Academy affirm the Board Certified Certificate sent to Akamai University which is a separate process to achieve.

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CAP Program Fees:

Total program Cost Varies Depending on the Role:

Healing through Creative Arts Program Practitioner \$1200,

Creative Arts Program Educator \$1800,

Creative Arts Practitioner \$3000.

Includes university continuing education with international accreditation, learning modules, spiritual development, mentorship, and certificate. Total of minimum of 12 – 30 CEU's to receive the certificate.

(1 CEU = 10 contact hours) Additional fees may be charged for additional mentorship to complete the program as needed beyond the basic program. All fees are payable to Energy Medicine Partnerships, Akamai University Affiliate who pays the fees required to Akamai University which includes University Continuing Education Units credit through Akamai University College of Continuing Education.

After each part is finished, contact hours will be awarded documenting the segment taken and the number of contact hours earned. Payment options are available. 10% discount for full payment paid after application is approved to start the studies with includes a zoom meeting to discuss the student's goal and clearly explain the process involved and answer any questions.

Part I training also available as stand-alone costs without registration for the whole program. A repeater fee for courses and modules is one/half the cost.

Limited partial scholarships are available for those in need and qualify. Payments are scheduled quarterly spread over 1 year or would consider another option after discussion with Dr. Bulbrook based on the students situation. The certificate for each part completed is given once paid for and word done.
