Re: Affiliate opportunities with Akamai University: Dance Debut Inc and The Canadian Association of BioEnergetic Wellness

Dear Board Members of Akamai,

Congratulations on the succession of the University as Dr. Capogrossi enters a well-deserved retirement, and Dr. Bulbrook takes the helm. This is an exciting time in history to see how the academic world can transform to support the development and the wellness of the human condition as well as the condition of the world as a whole.

I am extending a hand today to discuss some of the ways that collaboration may be able to happen with both my own wellness company, Dance Debut Inc., and also the organization of which I am currently the President of the Leadership Team for: The Canadian Association of BioEnergetic Wellness.

Currently my dissertation is deeply entrenched into the organizations, (canbewell.org), need to rebrand, rebuild, and reestablish a solid organization to support the continued learning in BioEnergetic Wellness tools. With this regard, we would like to collaborate on initiatives with Akamai University that extends across borders, collaborates with other students and countries, and supports initiatives in integrative health. Dr. Bulbrook and I have had these preliminary discussions, we created a special ambassador award program which saw recipients receive honors at a gala event in November 2020, and we have brainstormed potential opportunities which include our upcoming Wellness Summit in May 2021.

As part of the Summit activities, we would like to extend an invitation for Dr. Bulbrook to do the closing ceremony for the week-long conference and raise awareness about our affiliation. A formal invitation will be extended from the association this coming week, and the summit committee.

Further programming with CanBeWell may include a global program with the Choose Love Movement which is now in over a dozen countries around the world. Two members of our association are being trained as ambassadors this weekend, and one other Canadian is already trained. We hope to extend the value of this program as part of our associations outreach in Canada and beyond.

Also in the works is a collaboration with India and Nithya Poorani Jaharaj to develop youth initiatives that expand opportunities in both of our countries.

On behalf of my own company, Dance Debut Inc., I look forward to expanding the current programs that I create and teach into programming that can support energy medicine initiatives with Akamai University. The two latest creations, Raising BioEnergetic Awareness Module A and B, created with Master's student Natascha Polomski, is an excellent gateway into building energy awareness for other CAM studies. We have also co-authored with Cherry Whitaker a program called "Therapeutic Touch for Families" which is part of our youth initiative, as well as outreach to the public to know more about energy and self-empowerment in wellness.

My main area of study is wellness through movement, and I look forward to collaborations with others in Tai Chi, dance and somatics through the academic setting. As research is already being done in comparing and pairing Tai Chi with Therapeutic Touch, Healing Touch, and Reiki under the blanket term of BioField Therapies, there is a beautiful synergy to realize these approach wellness in a similar way.

I currently host a podcast: "Be Well with Michelle Greenwell" which can be found on Spotify and Buzzsprout. Once a month I share an interview with someone in the wellness field, and I also include a little self-care tip through tea and relaxation, as well as through a dance idea. This outreach I hope to expand in the coming year to include more collaborative relationships.

As we engage in discussion to address the global challenges created in health during the pandemic, I believe that my studies have positioned me in a solid position to build relationships, to find new pathways to help others, and to bring more clarity and power to the programs offered at Akamai University.

I look forward to continued success as you bring the new opportunities for Akamai University forward.
